Water and 14th Street Wheeling, WV



As part of the Wheeling Heritage Port project, Hays LAS designed a unique streetscape that not only interpreted the history of Wheeling but also expanded the usefulness of heritage port for concerts and festivals.

The design of the walk mimicked rails and boxcars with brick in concrete. This one block long, full-scale design is situated in the same location as the original rail line that traversed up the Ohio River on the (West) Virginia side. Between each boxcar is a granite logo paver representing the railroad companies that operated in Wheeling.

The tree-lined walk also is designed so that vendors can set up on the street and face inward toward Heritage Port with a fence behind. This allows for ample walk space while also creating an enclosed venue for ticketed events. Just behind the curb are custom, round electrical boxes that allow for easy vendor connection to portable electrical distribution centers.

Streetscape design along 14th Street between Water and Main Streets conformed to the city standards and improved business owner access to the buildings. New ADA accessible ramps were introduced as well as street trees.
